Notes –

- 1- This inflatable has been inspected to ensure it is safe to use, this must be set up and anchored using stakes 380mm x 16mm if outside - .
- 2- Must be supervised at all times.
- 3- Must not be used in winds including gusts over 24pmh, this should be check regularly whilst in use.
- 4- Operator must ensure the correct blower and an operating pressure of a minimum 1kpa is kept AT ALL TIMES, air pressure to be recorded prior to each use.
- 5- Mats to be used on all impact areas on hard ground areas.

Safety Warning

Before using inflatable devices operators must familiarise themselves with the manufacturers safety recommendations set out in the operating manual or user instructions for the device which must be complied with at all times. The following key points are especially important:

Before using the inflatable device:

1. Always check that the inflatable device is sited on a flat and anchored correctly
2. In the event of winds greater than Force 5 on the Beaufort scale (max 24mph / 38 km/h) which is when small trees in leaf begin to sway SWITCH OFF the inflatable device and do not use.
3. Ensure that all open sides of the inflatable device are covered by suitable safety mats.
4. Keep users of the inflatable device until it is fully inflated and anchored down.

When in use:

5. Only allow users of the same age / size on at the same time. Do not mix Adults & Children. Adults are only to be allowed on a device which is suitably designed for the purpose.
6. Do not allow too many users on at once - refer to table below for correct numbers - and these should be users become boisterous.
7. Do not allow users to act recklessly or intentionally play rough.
8. Always keep the entrance / exit clear. Do not allow users to obstruct or play on the floor slip.
9. Ensure that all users remove shoes and sharp objects (including spectacles). No food or drink is allowed on the inflatable device.
10. In the event of rain DO NOT USE THE INFLATABLE DEVICE. Once the rain has passed ensure the inflatable device is completely dry before commencing play.
